

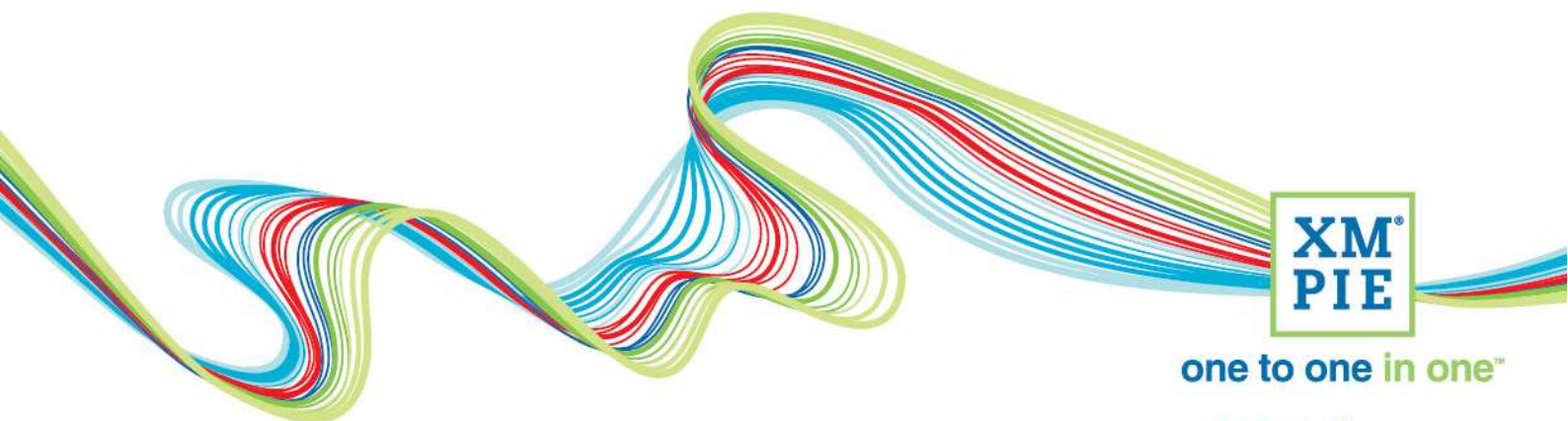

In this series of videos, we explore uCreate Print and how to create VDP or Variable Data Print templates in InDesign.

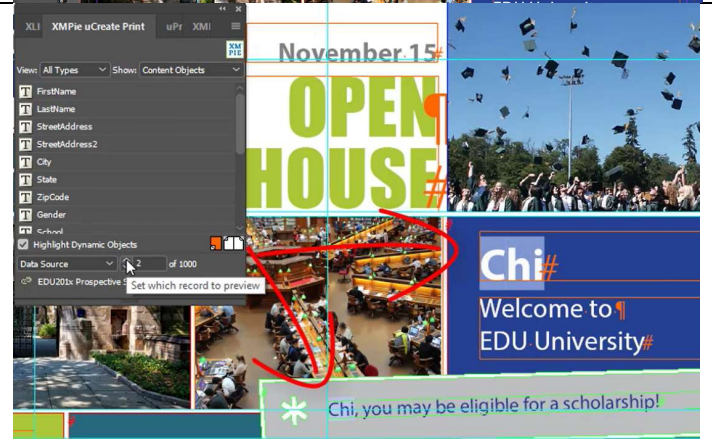
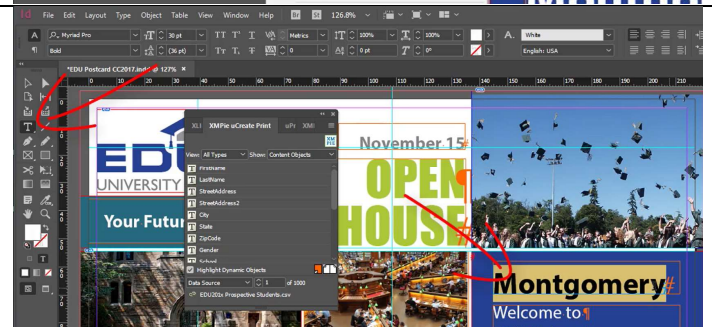
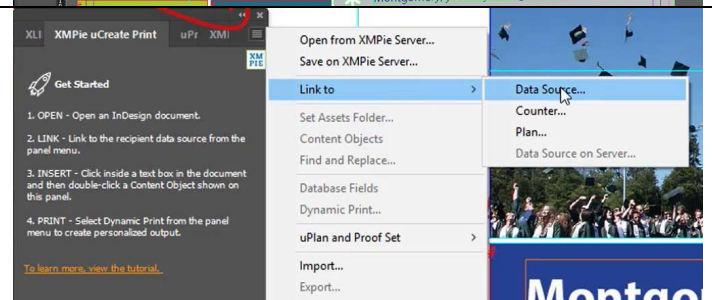
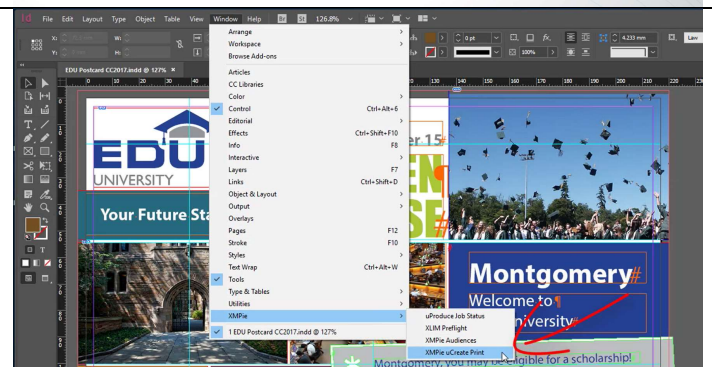
For those who want to get straight into it and experiment on their own: After installing uCreate Print, simply open an InDesign document and locate the uCreate Print panel from the Windows menu.

Use the panel menu to connect to your data source, and you will see all the columns or fields ready to place into the document.

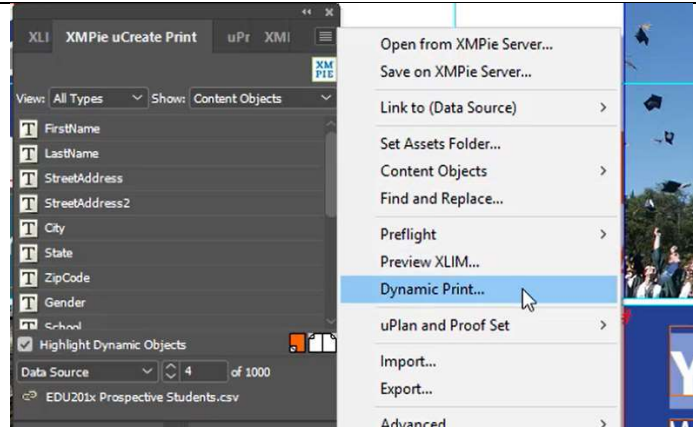
Use the InDesign Text tool to select where you want database values to appear, and double-click the content object in the uCreate Print panel.

You can scroll through your database records and see the design change in true WYSIWYG style.

When happy with your setup, you can create the final print output file by selecting the Dynamic Print option from the panel menu.
